This means people with disability would have no advocacy when things go wrong.

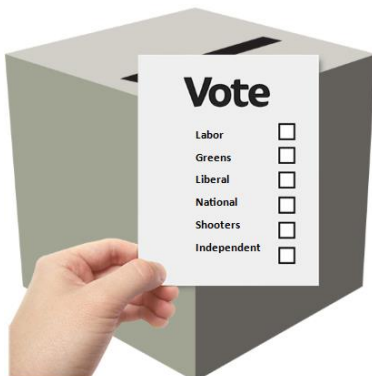
There would be no one on their side.
